The Spanish Language Advanced Placement process is for students who received a combined score of 46 or higher and who believe they have the skills to potentially waive additional Spanish language requirements in the Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences (BSHS) degree program at the University of Minnesota Rochester (UMR).

If you are interested in potentially waiving SPAN 1522: Spanish II or potentially all of your language requirements, follow the steps below:

1. **Respond to the essay questions at the bottom of this form.**
2. Email this form to umr-spanish-faculty@r.umn.edu with the subject of "Spanish Language Advanced Placement process."
3. A Spanish faculty will email you a written assessment within 7 days. *Please note: You will only be given 72 hours (including weekend hours) to complete this written assessment, so please plan accordingly. Email your answers to umr-spanish-faculty@r.umn.edu.
4. Within 7 days, you and your Student Success Coach will receive an email (with a copy of this form) from a Spanish faculty indicating whether you have placed into SPAN 2521. *If the Spanish faculty believes you are eligible to waive all Spanish language requirements (based on your results on the written email assessment), the email will ask that you schedule an oral evaluation with them, and your results will be emailed to you and your Student Success Coach (with a copy of this form) within 7 days of the oral evaluation.

Essay questions: Consider your responses carefully and edit your submission for both logic and grammar. You should write between 100 and 150 words for each question:

1. What is your formal background (i.e. high school/college education) in Spanish?

2. What is your informal background (i.e. travel experiences, home situations, etc. . . .) in Spanish?
