DIRECTIONS—Complete this form to be considered for the federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program. The TEACH Grant provides up to \$4,000 per year (\$16,000 total for 4-year under-graduate programs, and \$8,000 total for graduate programs) in grants to students who commit to:

1. teach full-time;
2. in high-need subject areas;
3. for at least four out of the first eight years teaching; **and**,
4. at schools that serve students from low-income families.

If the commitment is not fulfilled, the grant is permanently converted to a loan to be repaid by the recipient. The loan is a Ford Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan with interest calculated from the time of the grant disbursement.
